HBCS COVID-19 PROCEDURES



Temperature Checks: All students will be required to have daily, touchless temperature checks upon arrival, before exiting the vehicle. Please have students seated next to car window to ease process. Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will not be admitted to class and will be sent home immediately.



Face masks are strongly recommended but not required for students. HBCS staff will wear a face mask or face shield at all times. Please let your child's teacher know if you would prefer your child to wear a mask at any time.



HBCS will be enforcing social distancing and "no touching" policies as much as possible, including during class, restroom, recess, chapel, and carline times.



Since classes will have lunch time in the classroom, sack lunches (no microwavable items) will be recommended for the first nine weeks of school. Students will be required to bring bottled drinks with resealable lids to avoid spills.



Water fountains are off limits. Students may drink bottled water throughout the day, including bringing his or her own clear cannister of water to keep in the classroom.



At recess, students will not be allowed to share toys, books, puzzles, etc. Outside, a no-touch policy will be enforced, and students will not be allowed to push one another on the swing-sets.



Students will wash hands with soap and water after using the restroom, before and after snack/lunch times, and after recess. Students will use hand sanitizer upon entering the school, before and after entering/exiting classrooms, and frequently throughout the day.



HBCS is taking extra cleaning and disinfecting precautions before, during, and after school.



Parents/Visitors are not allowed in the classroom during the school day. Parents/Visitors must wear a mask if volunteering at the school or meeting with a teacher in a classroom before or after school. Parents/Visitors will not be required to wear a mask if visiting the school office only. Parents/Visitors will not be admitted into the school to check out a child. Call the school office 30 minutes <u>before</u> your arrival and upon your arrival to the school, and one of the office staff will escort your child to your vehicle.



Students will be sent home if showing persistent symptoms of COVID-19, such as coughing, sneezing, congestion, and loss senses of taste/smell. If a student or teacher contracts COVID-19 throughout the school year, the entire class will be required to self-quarantine at home for 14 days. The infected student or teacher will not be readmitted to class until he or she has been fever-free for 14 days. Virtual learning will be accessible for the quarantined class during such time.
